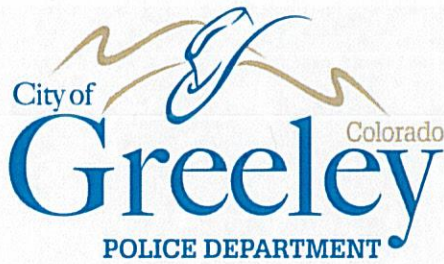

To whom it may concern,

This letter is to serve as the written explanation regarding the hiring of Spencer Davis by the Summit County Sheriff's Office (SCSO).

Prior to hiring Mr. Davis, the SCSO checked the Colorado Peace Officer database, which indicated Mr. Davis was, and is currently, POST Certified. We were also aware of the negative action against Mr. Davis, which indicated he was "Terminated for Cause" from the Colorado State Patrol (CSP) in June of this year.

Mr. Davis has been unconditionally transparent with the SCSO regarding the internal investigation completed by CSP that led up to his termination. Mr. Davis informed us he plans to exercise every type of appeal available to him, as he feels his termination was not justified. The SCSO has considered the circumstances surrounding the CSP disciplinary actions and determined that Mr. Davis is fit for duty and capable of exemplary performance.

After a complete and thorough hiring process and background investigation, including the circumstances surrounding the CSP disciplinary action, the SCSO decided to hire Mr. Davis.
