I, Deputy Devan Salazar, being duly sworn upon oath says that there is probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above-named defendant for the charges stated above, and that the following facts are true and correct to the best of his/her knowledge, information, and belief, and support the arrest of the defendant.

On 05/26/2026 at about 1844 hours I was dispatched to a cold domestic report at 22 W Bonanza Pl., outside of the Town of Parachute, in the County of Garfield, in the State of Colorado. Dispatch advised the parties would meet me at Bea Elementary school, but due to an emergent call for service I later met both parties at 234 Tamarisk Trail. I arrived on scene at 1936 hours. I met Elena Cervantes ( ) and Crystal Peck ( ). I asked Crystal to tell me what occurred. Crystal informed me that at about 1720 hours today Crystal and her husband, Talon, had a struggle over her cell phone. Talon had left for his shift at McDonald's and then all of a sudden showed back up at the house. Crystal was on the phone with her ( ) barber. Crystal was in the laundry room when Talon came home. Talon proceeded to go and take her phone away from her and head into their bedroom.

Crystal followed him into the bedroom and tried to get her phone back. Talon told her to "get the fuck out (meaning the house) and then proceeded to slam her Mac Book down. Talon tried to leave the room and Crystal stopped him trying to get her phone from him. Talon was very angry and accused Crystal of cheating on him. Talon proceeded to throw the phone in the direction of her ( ), as it went over ( ) head almost hitting ( ). Crystal went and picked the phone up. Talon came after her and tried to take the phone from her. Both parties fell to the ground and he was on top of her and managed to rip the phone out of her hand. Talon left the residence in his truck. Crystal and her ( ) left the residence and went to



a neighbor's house so she could make a phone call. Crystal called her friend, Elena, who showed up at the neighbor's house to pick her up.

Crystal and her [REDACTED] left the residence and went over to Bea Elementary school and called the police. Crystal said she was unsure if Talon was back at the residence or not. Elena stated that there was a Chrysler type vehicle circling the elementary school when they were waiting and they believe the occupants of the vehicle are related to Talon. This is when they went to a different friend's house located at [REDACTED]. I attempted to call Crystal's phone, but there was no answer.

I asked Crystal about the relationship with the male subject she was on the phone with when Talon came home. Crystal said he is [REDACTED] barber, but also advised they have been friends and talk every day. Crystal was somewhat reluctant to further expound upon their relationship. I asked Crystal to explain to me about her marriage to Talon. Crystal said they have been married for two years (together for three), making their relationship intimate in nature. Crystal said he [REDACTED] have a biological father and Talon is their step-father. Crystal said that both children, [REDACTED] were in the room when the physical altercation occurred. I asked Crystal why Talon would be this upset. Crystal said she was unsure, except that [REDACTED] barber has been giving her more attention than Talon and this maybe what is upsetting to him. I explained to Crystal that a reasonable husband would probably not be too happy if this was occurring and vice versa.

I drove over to the residence to look for Talon. As I arrived, I could see Talon with three other people in the driveway looking in my direction. There were also several white trash bags on the lawn. These three subjects were later identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Talon started walking towards me. I know Talon by sight as he was a former employee of the Garfield County Sheriff's Office and was assigned to the Detentions Division. I greeted Talon and we walked towards my vehicle since I was parked at the corner of Rainbow and W Bonanza. I asked Talon to tell me what happened.

Talon immediately stated something to the effect of "I found out my wife is a cheating whore!!" Talon said he left for to go to work at McDonald's. He passed a UPS truck and proceeded to turnaround because he remembered that he was supposed to receive a package today. When he arrived home, he entered the residence and found Crystal in the laundry room talking to another male on her cell phone. Talon became angry and took the phone from her and went into the bedroom. Crystal followed him and they began arguing. Talon went on to tell me that he believes Crystal has been cheating on him for the past month. I advised Talon that Crystal reported that the person she was talking to was only [REDACTED] barber. Talon stated he found heart emojis exchanged between the two, text messages stating I love you, and a picture of Crystal in this male's vehicle with a dozen roses.

Talon said he was angry and admitted to slamming down the laptop (Mac Book) and throwing the phone. Talon also admitted the phone was thrown in the vicinity of where Juan was standing, but it did not hit him. Talon said he packed up all of Crystal's stuff and placed it on the lawn. I had observed what I thought was four white trash bags, but later learned there was between 20-30. Talon said they continued to argue and he explained that Crystal had somewhat went to the ground as he was trying to get the cell phone back from her. Talon later changed his statement stating that he was partially on top of her, and then moved over to the side as he tried to get the cell phone away from Crystal. Crystal was on the floor with her hands tucked up underneath her chest area and had the cell phone tucked closely to her making it difficult for Talon to take. Talon had to put his hand underneath her and ripped the phone away from Crystal. Talon said during the struggle Crystal also had pushed him and he fell back onto their bed.

I asked Talon who was out in his driveway and he said it was his [REDACTED] Talon had called them and they came over and helped pack Crystal's stuff. Talon also stated that the locks were changed. Talon explained to me that he was upset about her cheating on him because he purchased the house for her and the kids. Talon also took the role of being the kids' father since they have been together. I asked Talon about the location of the cell phone and he said he packed it in one of the trash bags. Talon explained that he has purchased all of the items and what not. I explained to Talon that it did not matter, because they were married Crystal is entitled to all of the property just like he is.

Based on the evidence and information obtained from my investigation Talon is the aggressor in this incident and committed the offenses of Harassment and 2 counts of Child Abuse – Neglect ([REDACTED] were in the bedroom when they physical altercation occurred). I advised Talon he was under arrest and Sgt. Dimmick placed his handcuffs on his wrists. Sgt. Dimmick transported him to the Garfield County Detention Center.

I had a brief conversation with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were upset that Talon was going to jail. I explained to them that I determined that Talon was the aggressor in this incident and he was going to jail for harassment and DV. There was a brief discussion about the residence and other property items. I explained to all parties that due to Talon and Crystal being married that all property (whether Crystal purchased it or Talon purchased it) is owned by both parties until a court has determined an asset split during the divorce proceedings. [REDACTED] moved Talon's truck into the middle of the driveway. [REDACTED] took Talon's truck keys that way he could have them when he gets out of jail. Initially, I was okay with this, but later learned additional information.

I contacted [REDACTED] and explained to [REDACTED] what happened. A short time later [REDACTED] Crystal and the [REDACTED] returned to the house. I returned to the residence a short time later and observed approximately 20-30 white trash bags. Crystal said she could not find her phone or her Mac Book. There were numerous bags in the garage and several inside of the house. Crystal also stated that the locks had been changed and she did not have a key to the new lock. Crystal looked through several bags and finally found her cell phone undamaged. She still could not find her Mac Book. Furthermore, she did not have a truck key to move Talon's truck so she could access the Tesla that was parked in the garage.

I went to [REDACTED] residence located at [REDACTED] I had a brief conversation with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] retrieved the truck keys and the new residence key along with the old ones. I returned these to Crystal.

Later, Crystal informed me that [REDACTED] found her Mac Book in Talon's locked truck underneath the seat. Crystal said that her cell phone password had been changed and all of her text messages had been deleted to her male friend. Talon admitted to deleting these messages in my earlier conversation with him. Additionally, Crystal stated that the Tesla App was deleted off of her phone, the key card to access the Tesla was also missing, preventing her access to the vehicle. Based on the phone being in one of approximately 30 trash bags, the Mac Book purposely being hidden under Talon's truck seat, and the locks being changed I believe this was done by Talon in an effort to punish/retaliate against Crystal after finding out about her infidelity. Talon was also charged with 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Tampering.

Crystal was provided with a green VRA booklet and the on-call VRA Brennan was contacted and informed about what occurred this evening.
