

Director Erik Bourgerie,

In December 2021 Division Chief Mickey Bethel came to me and asked if I could help him sign into PoliceOne Academy to complete training hours to be in compliance with POST Rule 28. Chief Bethel then told me Undersheriff Tommie McLallen is 4 ½ hours short of his perishable skills. He stated since Undersheriff McLallen is currently in a training (Northwestern Public Safety and Command) that he, Chief Bethel, is going to complete the Undersheriff's training hours.

Chief Bethel later told me he tried to sign onto Undersheriff McLallen's PoliceOne account but was unable to do so. He asked me to help him to see if I could get into the Undersheriff's account, supplying me with his password, [REDACTED]. I told Chief Bethel I was unable to since I did not have the information required. Chief Bethel later told me he was able to sign onto the Undersheriff's account.

On Tuesday December 14th, 2021, Chief Bethel gave three PoliceOne Certificate's to Administrative Assistant [REDACTED] to enter into Benchmark. All three certificates have Undersheriff McLallen's name on them, two were for Defensive Tactics and one was for Driving.

On Thursday December 16th, 2021, Chief Bethel gave two more PoliceOne certificates to Administrative Assistant [REDACTED] to enter into Benchmark. Both of these certificates had Undersheriff McLallen's on them, both were for Firearms.

The Northwestern Public Safety training class concluded on Friday December 17th, 2021.

I have recently spoke with [REDACTED] and he told me in the past he has witnessed Chief Bethel sign training rosters for training that he did not attend.

I am notifying POST due to the unethical behavior and untruthfulness of Undersheriff McLallen and Chief Mickey Bethel.
