Hello Allison,

This is just to follow up on our previous phone conversation.

As I related, Mike Lorsung was Chief when it was determined he had embezzled by selling a Ford pickup that had been donated to the Town. CBI investigated, and Lorsung eventually plead guilty. It was later determined (after he pled to the first occurrence) he had done this same thing previously, and he was charged and convicted of that instance as well.

Since Lorsung was Chief, there was no one to do an internal investigation, and CBI (in Grand Junction) conducted the criminal investigation. Based on the amount of proof, he had been fired immediately upon CBI starting an investigation.

Related to Tyerek Kirkland, there is suspicion of violation(s) of department policy. He resigned after learning the department would be investigating those violations. His resignation noted personal reasons for his resignation, and did not mention an investigation. That investigation is ongoing, and so it is not available at this time. While nothing can ever be ruled out before an investigation is complete, it does not appear this will involve criminal behavior.
