Summary

INITATING INFORMATION

On 3/2/26 I Commander Williams was forwarded several email from the email [REDACTED]. The emails referenced a child abuse investigation and stated that it was not properly investigated.

COMPLAINANT ALLEGATION (Summary)

The below email was received by the PD Admin email.

The Weld County Sheriff’s Office and the Johnstown Police Department improperly classified a reported child abuse matter as a domestic issue, resulting in a failure to protect a vulnerable minor. Despite credible concerns, the agencies asserted the child’s safety without conducting an adequate, impartial investigation and discounted the child’s advocate, thereby denying due consideration to material evidence. This conduct reflects negligence, abuse of discretion, and a failure to fulfill their statutory duty of care. The actions taken prioritized institutional self-justification over the best interests of the child, exposing the child to continued harm. Such conduct constitutes an abuse of authority and discriminatory treatment toward a medically fragile individual. Accountability and remedial action are warranted.

I was able to view the BWC from the below incidents on February 28th that were referenced from the complaint email. A [REDACTED] year old male party was contacted by officers and confirmed that his mother had been calling in welfare checks for him as he had chosen to live with his father. No concerns for his safety were noted and he did not have any concerns to relay to the officers.

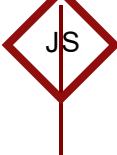
